## Terms and Conditions

Please read these Terms and Conditions ("Terms") carefully before using the services, website, or SMS communications offered by Maine Immigrants' Rights Coalition. By accessing our website, participating in our programs, or opting into our text messaging service, you agree to be bound by these Terms. If you do not agree, please do not use our services.

**Scope** These Terms apply to use of our website and digital resources, our SMS text messaging program, programs and services offered by MIRC, and the MIRC Hotline content submission platform (see Part III for additional terms). These Terms are intended to be read alongside our Privacy Policy (Part II).

**Eligibility** By using our services, you represent that you are at least 18 years of age, or that you are accessing our services under the supervision of a parent or legal guardian who agrees to these Terms on your behalf. Our SMS program is available only to individuals with a valid U.S. mobile phone number.

### SMS Text Messaging Terms

#### Consent and Enrollment

By opting into our SMS program, you expressly consent to receive recurring text messages from MIRC at the mobile number you provided. Messages may include service updates, event reminders, program announcements, and other organizational communications. Message frequency varies.

#### Message and Data Rates

Standard message and data rates may apply depending on your mobile carrier and plan. MIRC is not responsible for any charges assessed by your carrier.

#### Opt-Out

You may opt out at any time by replying STOP to any message. You may receive one confirmation message, after which no further texts will be sent unless you re-enroll. To re-enroll, reply START or contact us directly.

MIRC does not guarantee the delivery, timing, or accuracy of any text message. Delivery is subject to your carrier's network availability. MIRC is not liable for undelivered, delayed, or misdirected messages.

#### Accuracy of Contact Information

You are responsible for providing and maintaining an accurate and current mobile phone number. MIRC is not liable for messages sent to an outdated or incorrect number you have provided.

### Website Use

#### Permitted Use

You may use our website for lawful, personal, and non-commercial purposes consistent with MIRC's mission. You agree not to use our website to transmit harmful, offensive, or unlawful content, or to interfere with the website's functionality or security.

### **Ownership and Consent**

The creator of the Content owns it. By submitting Content, you acknowledge that you either created the Content or, if you did not create it, that you have full permission to share it with MIRC in accordance with these terms.

### **Permission to Use the Content**

You give MIRC permission to use the Content in any manner that MIRC believes supports our community and furthers our mission. MIRC commits to appropriate, safe, and careful use of all Content. MIRC may share the Content with attorneys, legal representatives, advocacy partners, or other parties as necessary to fulfill our mission.

### **Imminent Danger**

MIRC will contact emergency services or other authorities if the Content reveals a threat of imminent danger to life or property. In this event, MIRC may share any and all information it has regarding the Content with the relevant authorities, without prior notice to the submitter.

### **No Payment or Credit**

You will not be paid for submitting Content. MIRC may not retain information about the source of the Content. MIRC will not identify or credit you in connection with the Content without your express consent, except in situations involving imminent danger as described above.
